### Dual Enrollment Grant Guidelines

Chesapeake College has been given authorization by the Mid-Shore Community Foundation to work with Caroline County Public Schools to implement the \$25,000 Roberta B. Holt Dual Enrollment Grant each year (fall and spring semesters only). This grant has been made possible by the generosity of Dr. Roberta B. Holt to greatly expand early access to college education to Caroline County high school students and help these students accelerate attainment of their educational and career goals. The student and parent/guardian must meet all the following guidelines to be given full consideration for grant funds:

- Student and parent must be residents of Caroline County.
- Student must be enrolled in Colonel Richardson High School or North Caroline High School.
- Student must meet the eligibility requirements for the Dual Enrollment Program set forth by Chesapeake College and Caroline County Public Schools.
- Student must be pre-registered for college courses in order to be considered for a grant each semester.
- Student may register for a full- or part-time credit load, pending approval of the college and the high school.
- Students must reapply each semester to be considered for funding.

Roberta B. Holt grant applications received by June 1<sup>st</sup> for the Fall Semester and by December 10<sup>th</sup> for the Spring Semester will be given first consideration and will be based on the availability of funds.
