Dual Enrollment Grant Guidelines

Chesapeake College has been given authorization by the Mid-Shore Community Foundation to work with Dorchester County Public Schools to implement the \$20,000 George B. Todd Dual Enrollment Grant each year (fall and spring). This grant has been made possible by the generosity of George G. Todd to greatly expand early access to college education to Dorchester County high school students and help these students accelerate attainment of their educational and career goals. The student and parent/guardian must meet all the following guidelines to be given full consideration for grant funds:

- Student and parent must be residents of Dorchester County.
- Student must be enrolled in Cambridge South Dorchester or North Dorchester High School.
- Student must meet the eligibility requirements for the Dual Enrollment Program set forth by Chesapeake College and Dorchester County Public Schools.
- Student must be pre-registered for college courses in order to be considered for a grant each semester.
- Student may register for a full- or part-time credit load, pending approval of the college and the high school.
- Students must reapply each semester to be considered for funding.

George B. Todd grant applications received by June 1st for the Fall Semester and by December 10th for the Spring Semester will be given first consideration and will be based on the availability of funds.
